

RULES FOR MEMBERS' USE OF THE RECREATION CENTRE FOR FUNCTIONS

- All Association cutlery, crockery and glassware can be used but must be washed and returned to the cupboards after the function. The use of the dishwasher is permitted.
- Any breakages of cutlery, crockery and glassware must be reported. The replacement cost will be the responsibility of the respective member
- Any damage to the Recreation Centre and furniture must be reported and the resulting costs to repair any damage or replace any items will be the responsibility of the respective member
- The cleaning of the Recreation Centre and the toilet areas both before the function (if necessary) and after the function will be the responsibility of the respective member. The Recreation Centre and its surroundings must be left properly clean after the function.
- All cleaning materials including items such as dishwashing liquid, tea towels etc are to be provided by the respective member
- All toilet supplies and towels are to be provided by the respective member
- No access to the gym area is permitted under any circumstances. A sign should be placed on the access door to this effect by the respective member
- The gates to the two enclosed pool areas must be locked to ensure no entry during the function, unless the function is an authorised and supervised BBQ and pool function
- No liquor, bottles or glassware are to be taken into enclosed pool areas under any circumstances
- No smoking is permitted in the Recreation Centre and both pool areas including the grassed area in front of the outdoor pool. Any cigarette butts must be cleared from the surrounding area of the Recreation Centre as part of the cleaning after the function.
- The noise level from music or a musician or a band must not exceed a level that will cause a nuisance with other owners or residents in surrounding houses or villas
- All evening functions must in all cases cease at midnight (12am)
- All guests should be requested to vacate at the designated time, to return quietly to their accommodation, or to leave the Resort quietly.
